How to search for courses: go to classes.uoregon.edu. Pick the current term's class schedule. If you want to search for classes to be offered in a future term, change the term in the URL to the next digit. For example, if the URL says 202001, change it to 202002. Also, check the prior quarters to see when the course was offered in the past. In most cases (in PPPM, at least), classes offered once/year will be offered the same quarter the following year.
